



Plastic Dunnage Return Procedures (Brite Can Sales)

Customers who have paid for a refundable deposit for plastic dunnage when purchasing Cans with GW Kent can follow the below process to return material and receive a refund. Customer is responsible for the freight cost of returned dunnage.

- All dunnage must be clean, dry, and free of contamination.
- Dunnage cannot have any damage to receive a full refund.
- Dunnage must be prepared as follows:
 - Base Pallets
 - Maximum high of 22 for full truck load. Smaller orders will ship LTL and can only be stacked 18 high for trailer door clearance.
 - Band or wrap pallets for secure travel.
 - Separator Sheets
 - Squarely stacked on a base pallet up to 24" tall (40 sheets).
 - Place a top frame on top the completed pallet and secure with strapping.
 - Top Frames
 - Stack on a base pallet up to 50 high and secure with strapping.
- Each pallet should be labeled with GW Kent.
- Customer must complete the Dunnage Return form and attach it to the BOL when shipping to GW Kent.

Dunnage Costs (Cost Per Unit)

- Bottom Pallet: \$80
- Top Frame: \$25
- Separator Sheets: \$3.50

Cost Per Item

- 12 oz. Brite Standard Can (10 Rows) : \$140
- 12 oz. Brite Standard Can (11 Rows) : 143.50
- 12 oz. Brite Standard Can (21 Rows) : \$182
- 12oz. Brite Sleek Can (16 Rows) : \$164.50
- 12oz Brite Sleek Cans (8 Rows) : \$136.50
- 16 oz. Brite Standard Can (16 Rows) : \$164.50
- 16 oz. Brite Standard Can (8 Rows) : \$136.50
